Objectives

- 1 To facilitate the continuation of the education program aimed at the shire's existing and new Liquid Trade Waste customers and to help continue compliance with the NSW Office of Water concurrence guidelines for Liquid Trade Waste discharges to the sewerage system.
- 2 The policy then requires registration with the NSW Office of Water for concurrence purposes.

Policy

- 1 The positive implications for the adoption of this Policy include reducing the number of surcharges and odours related to grease arrestors and the reduction of undesirable substances and flows entering the sewerage system.
- 2 This aids in the efficient operation of Council's sewerage treatment works, associated infrastructure and helps Council remain compliant within EPA guidelines.
- 3 The Shire's liquid trade waste customers will continue to be made aware of the possible implications of the policy to their businesses.
- 4 This is an updated policy required by NSW Office of Water to meet the Concurrence Guidelines and is part of Council's Best Practice Management.
