

Did you know?

- Sorting waste properly keeps costs down for the community over the long term
- Everything you put into the red bin ends up in the local landfill and costs much more to process than recycling or organics
- 6,100 tonnes of red bin waste is collected annually in the Kempsey Shire. Much of that could be recycled or composted
- A recent bin audit showed most of the waste in our red bins doesn't belong there:

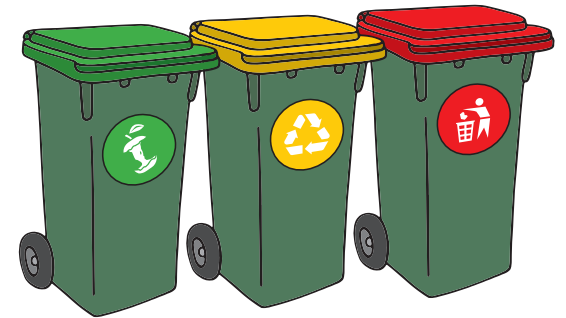

YOUR NEW WASTE SERVICE

Starts 1 July 2017

YOUR NEW WASTE SERVICE Starts 1 July 2017

All households with a waste service will receive:

- a new **GREEN** bin for all food and garden organics, collected WEEKLY
- a new **YELLOW** bin for household recycling, collected FORTNIGHTLY
- new **RED** bin for rubbish, collected FORTNIGHTLY
- a new bin collection calendar – **your bin pick up days may change**
- FREE kitchen caddy and recycling bag with your new bins

FREE KITCHEN CADDY

A kitchen caddy and compostable bag system to help make it easy to collect all food scraps in the kitchen for disposal in the **GREEN** bin.



FREE RECYCLING BAG

A handy bag for collecting all household recycling for easy disposal in the **YELLOW** bin.

STANDARD



The Standard Service will suit most households.

The new bin sizes mean more space for your waste for the majority of residents over a fortnightly period.

The easiest way to make the new service work for you is to put all food and garden waste into the **GREEN** bin, and all household recycling into the **YELLOW** bin.

What do I need to do to order the Standard Service?

Nothing. All households will automatically receive the Standard Service unless you contact us to make another selection. \$403*

*Waste service charge in 2017-18 rates, subject to Council adoption at June 2017 meeting.

OPTIONS

SMALL

If you have a small household of 1 or 2 people and you don't produce much waste, you may wish to opt for a Small Service. \$351*



RECYCLING UPSIZE

A larger yellow bin for households who have more recycling than most. Additional \$10*

What do I need to do to order the Small Service or Recycling Upsize?

RENTING? Contact your real estate agent to discuss your bin size needs with your landlord.

Your new bins will be delivered in June 2017, ready for the start of the new service from 1 July 2017. Keep an eye out in May for further information about bin deliveries.
