


NSW Farm Safety Advisory Program

NSW Fire Ant Program update

The NSW Fire Ant response continues following detections of the invasive species Solenopsis invicta at Murwillumbah in November 2023 and Wardell in January 2024, and an interception at Clunes on 13 November 2024.

Following the Clunes interception, the Department took immediate action by placing a temporary suspension of turf movements from QLD fire ant infested areas into ANY part of NSW. Due to the swift response by contractors, the landholder and the NSW Fire Ant Program team, broader movement controls in the 5 km around the infested premises are not required.

Report pest sighting easily with FeralScan

Better manage and monitor cane toads, wild dogs, feral pigs, deer and other pests on your place with FeralScan. Use the free FeralScan app or visit the FeralScan website to record sightings, damage and control of feral animals.

It's quick and easy to use plus your records are private and confidential.

Monitoring is important to help understand the extent of the problem and better target effective control.

Farm Household Allowance

This program aims to provide targeted assistance that gives farmers and their partners practical support to assess their situation and plan a way forward to long term financial security. It is an Australian Government support package available to eligible farmers and their partner experiencing financial hardship when the income fluctuates to a low level.

Review of the non-urban metering rules

The NSW Government has reviewed the non-urban water metering framework with key changes in the Water Management (General) Regulation 2018 recommended to accelerate compliance. The aim of the review is to ensure the majority of all licensed water entitlement is measured with accurate, auditable and tamper-evident metering equipment.

This will not impact residents who have Council supplied water meters but it will affect properties that have water access licenses issued through Water NSW, such as stock and domestic or irrigation licenses. Feedback closes on Sunday 8 December 2024.
