




Craig Milburn to step down as General Manager in December

Local Sport Defibrillator Grant Program

The Local Sport Defibrillator Grant Program is aimed at providing Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) and associated equipment to NSW sport and recreation facilities and clubs.

An AED is a device that is used in conjunction with Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and delivers a controlled shock to an individual experiencing cardiac arrest, increasing their chances of survival.

- Program opens: 9.00am Tuesday 17 September 2024
- Program closes: Upon funding allocation being exhausted or by 1:00 pm on 27 November 2024 whichever is earlier *

The grant amount will fund the cost of an approved AED package up to \$3,000. Apply today to promote wider access to these devices across NSW.
