NSW Government Launches Varroa Management Tool

The NSW Government has launched an innovative online Varroa Management Tool to help commercial and recreational beekeepers tackle the challenges of Varroa mite.

Unveiled at Australia's longest-running beekeepers' field day at Tocal College, the tool was met with strong industry support. It guides users through questions about their hive conditions, such as mite treatment thresholds, brood presence and colony development. Based on their responses, it suggests tailored treatment options, including cultural, mechanical and chemical solutions.

This tool empowers beekeepers with informed strategies to manage Varroa mites and safeguard the health of their hives.
